
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About $ITIL^{\mathbb{R}}$ 4

ITIL 4 reshapes established ITSM practices in the wider context of customer experience, value streams, digital transformation and systems thinking.










Digital Transformation

Digital transformation is the use of digital technology to enable a <u>significant</u> improvement in the realization of an organization's objectives that could not have been feasibly achieved by non-digital means.



High-Velocity IT


High-velocity IT is the application of digital technology for significant business enablement, where <u>speed is crucial</u>.





- Enables higher degrees of digital enablement... but there's a cost

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

Key Behavior Patterns for High-Velocity IT




HVIT behaviors are supported by a combination of guiding principles, models and concepts that inform "how we do things around here" – in other words, culture.

Key Characteristics of High-Velocity IT



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- Lean helps to improve throughput and reduce waste
- Agile adds close and iterative collaboration with users
 - **Resilient** maintains workable availability and performance
 - Continuous ensures fast and reliable development

When combined and used together properly, these characteristics enable the co-creation of value.
